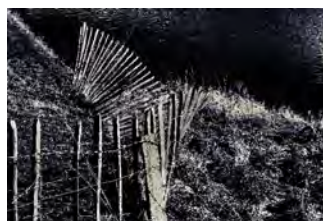
This is his second exhibition at Oriel Q, curated by Lynne Crompton.

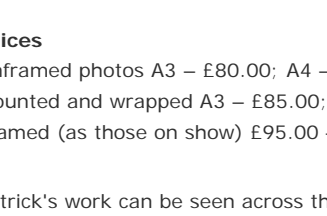

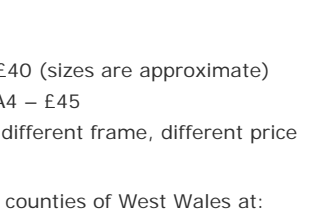
